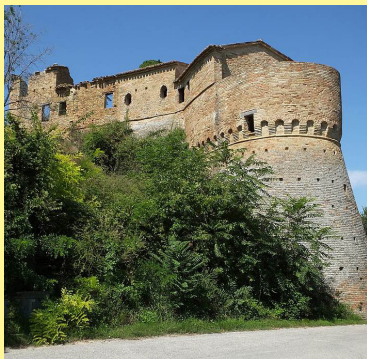

Visit to the St Thomas Abbey. The Abbey was built around 980 on the remains of a pre-existing Roman-era temple by Benedictine monks. It was part of an imposing complex consisting of the monastery with the cloister, the cemetery, the houses and the houses of the family. Of great beauty remains the majestic Romanesque church with three naves, on the facade the white stone portal decorated by a bifore.

Gabicce Mare is not only “sea”, but ideal starting point for trips in the green hinterland to discover fascinating places rich in art and history. The “monte” of Gabicce is part of the Natural Park of San Bartolo, a must for nature walks admiring the breathtaking view. **Gabicce Monte, Vallugola Bay, Casteldimezzo, Fiorenzuola di Focara, Santa Marina Alta**, are the destinations for the visits of nature lovers.

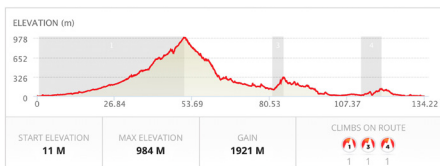

Monday, 22 April 2019: MAIOLO (km 134,22 round trip)



The present village of **Maiolo**, located on the middle valley of the Marecchia river, is a scattered mountain town that has taken its place, inheriting its name, of the homonymous village near it, destroyed, according to a legend wrapped in an aura of mystery, in a night of late May of 1700 from a ruinous landslide that still intrigues the geological and historical.

Until 1700, the ancient Maiolo was a populated and flourishing country, surmounted by a massive fortress surrounded by walls and towers, strategic point of the village and the entire Val Marecchia.

Today, only two mighty polygonal towers remain on the top of the mountain, from which the entire Marecchia valley dominates, while today's village is in a nearby town called Serra. Today Maiolo preserves its villages, its old farmhouses, the squares and has not let itself be infected by the wild condominium buildings. The dazzling beauty of the sunsets, the look that ranges from Mount Fumaiolo to the Alpe della Luna, Mount Carpegna, the towers of San Leo, the towers of San Marino to the sea, make Maiolo a unique vantage point of the Marche region and of Montefeltro.

The city is famous above all for its characteristic bread, produced with local flours and with traditional methods, to which a special annual fair, the **Bread Festival**, is dedicated at the end of June.

Tuesday, 23 April 2019:

Excursion to MONTEFABBRI/Vallefoglia (km 63,23 road trip)



The name Montefabbri, of uncertain origin, presumably derives from Monte Fabrorum, or the castle of the Fabbri family.

History

VII-VIII century, the descent of the Franks coincided with the formation of the parishes, like one of San Gaudenzio. XII century, in the territory of the parish church of San Gaudenzio there are four castles, one of which is that of Montefabbri. XIII century, the fortunes of the castle are linked to those of the lords of Urbino and Rimini, i Montefeltro and the Malatesta, who were competing back then. XIV century, alternation of power between the Montefeltro and the church. XV century, the castle of Montefabbri enters more and more in the orbit of the Duchy of Urbino, for whom was supplied soldiers and captains. 1578, the Duke of Urbino nominates count of the fief of Montefabbri the civil and military architect Francesco Paciotti. In the 1744, the village passed definitively to the State Papal. 1862, with the opening of a police station and the killing of the criminal Terenzio Grossi, an end to local banditism, aimed at the restoration of the government Pontifical against the unitary state. 1869, Montefabbri lose its administrative autonomy and is annexed to the Municipality of Colbordolo. Humble little houses, close to each other, are enclosed in the circle of the castle walls of this small village that stands out lonely along the ancient road that connects Pesaro and Urbino. In the deep fantasy of open space of the hills silence broken by birdsong and by the sound of the bells. They are days of vivid grasses, country lanes, of small talk in the only bar, those that pass in Montefabbri. A picture left unchanged over the centuries. A landscape that could be the background of a painting of the Renaissance period, since a few steps from here was born the father of Renaissance, Raffaello Sanzio. A village that leaves you stunned: not only because it is beautiful (which means simple, intimate, collected: not expect great things) but, literally, because in the church of San Gaudenzio guards the scagliole, that is the oldest stucco decorations in the Marche region. The place is an excellent starting point for the art cities of Urbino, Gradara, San Leo, but also suitable for living nature in all seasons.

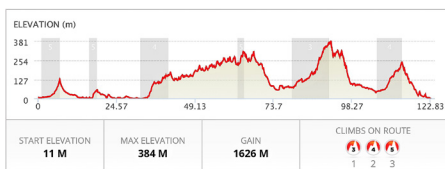

Wednesday, 24 April 2019: MONDAVIO (km 122,83 round trip)



Symbol of the village of Mondavio is the Rocca Roveresca, built between 1482 and 1492, which constituted an impregnable fortress for the whole territory. La Rocca now houses the Museum of Historical Reenactment and Armory, with white and firearm weapons from the period of the rover, in the moat there are some war machines faithfully reconstructed on the basis of drawings by Francesco di Giorgio Martini, the architect who designed and erected the Rocca. The ideal itinerary to discover the history of Mondavio begins with a visit to the civic art gallery located inside the Franciscan cloister. The Civic Art Gallery houses numerous paintings, furnishings and furnishings mainly from religious buildings. Particular attention deserves rare editions from the fifteenth to the seventeenth century from the library of Capuchin friars, who settled in Mondavio in the 1557. Among the valuable works there are incunabula (15th century movable prints) and Cinquecentine. The visit to the Apollo Theater which rises on the northwest walls, with entrance from Piazza della Rovere. The theater dates back to the late eighteenth century and was obtained from a previous church dedicated to San Filippo Neri, the theater was completely renovated in 1887 following the aesthetic canons of the belle époque. Returning working after the restoration, it hosts a remarkable theatrical season. The visit to the Insigne Collegiata building which was founded in the 14th century, but was renovated in 1563 by Bartolomeo Genga. The dedication of the church to Saints Peter and Paterniano, dates back to 1444 and derives from the unification of two parishes distant from each other, while the elevation to Insigne Collegiata is from 1741, when it was necessary to expand the church because it had become the most important in the area. Inside are works of exquisite workmanship such as the guardian angel of the eighteenth-century Bottani. And finally a visit to the Church of San Francesco. Tradition has it that the church was built by the will of St. Francis of Assisi on the occasion of his stop at Mondavio in the thirteenth century. The current internal structure corresponds to the reconstructions of the eighteenth century while the facade has preserved the austerity and simplicity that have always distinguished the buildings of the Franciscan Order. The interior of the church preserves valuable works; among all the most important is a table depicting the "immaculate conception" of the painter Giuliano Presutti.

(km 57,1 round trip)



GRADARA - Italy's best medieval town 2018

Situated at 142 metres above sea level, with the Republic of San Marino, Rimini and Carpegna in the background, Gradara represents an extraordinary urban and architectural combination.

Legend has it that the castle was the scene of the famous and tragic love story of Paolo and Francesca, caught in each other's arms and killed by Gianciotto, Francesca's husband. This love story was immortalized by Dante in his Divine Comedy.

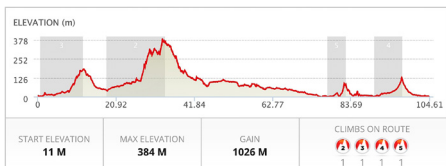

Friday, 26 April 2019: FOSSOMBRONE

(km 104,61 round trip)



In the valley of Metauro, on the route of the ancient Via Flaminia, lies Fossombrone, a beautiful city full of history, whose name derives from Forum Sempronii, an ancient Roman center that was known for a period of splendor in the imperial era. The ideal itinerary to discover the most characteristic spots of Fossombrone begins with a walk in the heart of the historic center: Corso Garibaldi. One of the first monuments is the Church of San Filippo dating back to 1600 with its baroque majesty. Concordia Bridge on the Metauro River is a magical place for its artistic beauty. From here, canoe trips go to the Marmitte dei Giants, the canyon of the Marches. A real jewel is the Casa Museo - Quadreria Cesarini. Fossombrone is the city of the three courts.

The Corte Alta is the old Renaissance palace and residence of the city's lords wanted by Federico da Montefeltro and can be reached via two staircases: the first is the one that starts from the "Palace of the Magistrate", in front of the Cathedral of Piazza Mazzini the arches of the palace. The second one is Via Lavinia Feltre della Rovere, where you can get off the street near the church of San Filippo.

The low court was one of the Della Rovere residence in Fossombrone. It is a sixteenth-century building with a porch, sandstone windows, flat rooftop portal. At the end there are private homes.

And finally, the Sempronii archaeological site where you can admire the ruins of the Roman city, founded in the II sec. B.C.

The Casa Museo was the private residence of notary Giuseppe Cesarini, a singular figure of patrons who during his lifetime (1895-1977) picked up one of the most important collections of contemporary art in the Marches. In the "Quadreria" you can admire works by Carpi, Morandi, Severini, Fussi, Messina, Tosi.

Very extensive - over 60 paintings - the section devoted to Anselmo Bucci, an artist from Fossombrone, a friend of Cesarini and a prominent exponent of Italian paintings of the twentieth century.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION AND REGISTRATION

PARTICIPATION:

Participants from abroad are admitted to the event with a valid ID of the responsible national cycling federation (UCI member).

Participants without an UCI federation membership can buy an ACSI day ticket at the price of Euro 10.00 per day, more information can be found on the homepage ciclismo.acsi.it

Cyclists who want to participate in several stages of the event can solve a year pass at the organizing cycling club.

In order to use the day ticket, you must bring a medical certificate valid in 2019 for the practice of cycling in accordance with regulation no. 19/2015 of the Italian Bicycle Federation.

AMBULANCE SERVICE:

ESCORT VEHICLES:

Only official escort vehicles with pass are allowed.

TIMEKEEPING:

The times are determined by means of Winning-Time-Chip. Participants can bring their own regular 2019 chip or buy or rent the chip. More information on chip rental or purchase at the picking up the starting numbers.

During the tours, surprise checks will be carried out and the following number of points will be awarded:

1 point for each cyclist attending the technical meetings on April 20-21-22-23-24-25.

1 point for every cyclist who starts every morning

5 points for each cyclist in the plane

10 points for every cyclist for the hillside stages

15 points for every cyclist participating in the GRANFONDO race on April, 22

THE FOLLOWING POINTS WILL BE AWARDED TO THE 3 LEADING CYCLISTS AT THE GRANFONDO RACE, WHICH WILL ALSO BE ENTERED INTO THE TEAM RANKINGS

The award ceremony will take place on the same day; the LEADER tricot is handed over to the TEAM CAPTAIN and should be worn by him.

BICYCLE TOURING RANKINGS – PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY:

Only the clubs participating in all seven cycling stages with at least five starters will be included in the overall ranking. The first 10 clubs that participated in all stages will be awarded. The daily and final rankings also include clubs with fewer than five starters. The following ranking is created by summing up the points that the individual participants of a club have collected during the week. The team with the highest number of points will receive the trophy TROFEO XXXIX Settimana Cicloturistica Internazionale al mare. The other teams receive gift baskets with gastronomic products.

THE WINNING TEAM GOBLET will be handed over to the winning club for the whole year and will have to be restituted for the 40th edition. The GOBLET remains in the winning club after the 4th consecutive victory. Furthermore, the team with the highest number of participating athletes, who drive over the target carpet within one minute, will be awarded..

Special awards will be given to:

the participant with the longest distance

the youngest and the least young participant

the participant with the lowest score gets the black tricot

There will be a special "Uphill Time Trial Prize" (with special surprise control checks)

ALL AWARDS WILL BE AWARDED DURING THE PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY ON THE EVENING ON FRIDAY APRIL 6th, 2019 at 9:30 pm.

RULES:

The organizers expressly point out that, as mentioned in the conditions of participation, cyclists driving before the Road Police car will be disqualified.

FURTHER REGULATIONS:

The organizers are not liable for themselves or their employees for accidents or damage to persons or things that should occur before, during and after the event. All cyclists must observe the rules of the traffic regulations.

Cyclists who are riding outside the caravan limited and protected by the convoy technique, and before or behind the means with the writing "INIZIO E FINE MANIFESTAZIONE CICLOTURISTICA" (START AND END OF THE CYCLING EVENT) are responsible from a civil or criminal point of view. The program during the week may change for reasons independent of the will of the organizers. The organizers reserve the right to announce program changes in the morning before departure.



GRANFONDO DEL MARE

The regulation is valid that relating to the Bicycle Touring Week. The caravan of the Bicycle Touring Week will stop for refreshment and meeting with family in Maiolo. Those who join the Granfondo del Mare will continue beyond refreshment, even on their own without waiting for the caravan, as scheduled. The entire route will be marked with colored signal arrows, which will indicate the path to follow.

The Organizers do not accept any responsibility, either for themselves or their colleagues/organizational staff, for any accidents or damage to people or things which may occur before, during and after the event or as a result of the same.

For entry to the trail you need a medical certificate for non competitive sports activities.
